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Anti-Bullying Policy

In Caegarw, we are committed to reducing the incidence and effects of bullying behaviour.

We place emphasis on respecting, valuing and caring for ourselves and others.

Bullying involves repeatedly taking advantage of someone in a way that is hurtful and rejecting. It can be:

- Verbal eg being called names/nasty comments
- Social eg no-one talking to you/being excluded from games etc
- Mental eg being threatened in any way
- Physical eg being hit/assaulted
- Cyber eg online pressure and harassment
- Material eg possessions stolen/property damaged

PROCEDURE FOR DEALING WITH INCIDENTS OF BULLYING BEHAVIOUR

When a member of staff is informed of an alleged incidence of bullying, the child making the complaint should be immediately sent to the Headteacher. If the Headteacher considers that the incident is one of bullying this will be recorded in the incident book and an incident form completed. **(Appendix A)**

Both sets of parents will be informed using standard letters. **(Appendix B)**

If the same child is accused of bullying behaviour on 3 occasions, a Step 1 letter will be issued to parents inviting them to discuss how the pattern of bullying can be broken. **(Appendix C)**

Following this interview, if the child is involved in a further incident of bullying, he/she will be immediately excluded.

All incidents of bullying will be reported to the LEA

THE HEADTEACHER WILL REGULARLY MONITOR BULLIED CHILDREN IN ORDER THAT THE PATTERN OF BULLYING DOES NOT RESUME.
